## RECOMMENDED TRAINING & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

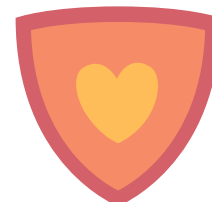
